In this position, you will be responsible for relationship-building with families, group program facilitation, new program development as indicated by community/family needs and providing information and supported referrals to community based resources and services.

The position requires a flexible work schedule including daytime, some evening and Saturday shifts.

The successful candidate will have:

- Education in Early Childhood Development, Education, Health or the Human Services Field
- Minimum 2 years' experience working with children and families from diverse cultural and socio-economic backgrounds
- Minimum of 2 years' experience in group facilitation
- A thorough working knowledge of community resources
- Excellent interpersonal skills and written and verbal communication skills
- Strong knowledge of early child development and parenting practices
- Excellent time management and organization skills
- Solid computer proficiency in Word, Outlook, and the ability to work both independently and within a large multidisciplinary team environment
